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| <p>1) Apologies: To receive apologies and to approve reasons for absence. Apologies received from:- Cllr Pullen Planning & Open Spaces Committee due to his stay at hospital during the day, Cllr Coulter Planning & Finance due to a cold. Cllr Lumbers Open Spaces & Finance as his care support was unwell and no substitute could be found. Cllr Davis Finance due to a very early working start the following day.</p> <p>2) Declarations of Interest: a) Register of Interests: Councillors are reminded of the need to update their register of interests. b) To declare any Personal Interests in items on the Agenda and their nature. See attached notesc) Enforcements - None <p>4) Open Spaces : To consider define and agree the Parish grass cutting requirements for 2009, prior to being put to tender. The Committee reviewed the cutting activity for the previous two years against the maps and draft tender documents provided. Additionally consideration was given to including Manchester Terrace and Botany Brook areas although these were currently undertaken by WDC. The Committee resolved that Manchester Terrace should be included within the tender papers to obtain and establish costs, although at this stage was not inclined to undertake the work, and that Botany Brook should be excluded as it was not feasible to include. The Clerk to commence with the tender process, to include the existing contractors and those who have registered an interest.</p> <p>5) Finance: As only two members of the Finance Committee were available Cllr Detsiny declared the meeting not to be a quorum and those items, the Risk Assessment, Asset Register and Council Insurance Annual reviews as a requirement of the external auditor would be considered by a working group of the Committee for expediency and onward recommendation.</p> <p>There being no further business the meeting closed at 8:30</p> <p>Signed.....
