The use of the land for the stationing of a residential mobile home shall cease on or before 12 months of the decision (17/10/08) and at the end of that period shall be removed and the land restored; The mobile home permitted shall not exceed 30sq meters in floor area; & not more than one residential home shall be stationed on the land at any one time. This information will be contained within the Clerks report for the benefit of the other members of the Council.
