Council agreed to pay an annual fee of £150.00 to the website provider to enable this.

8) Sandyfield Allotments

i) Access to allotment site

Council discussed improving the access into Sandyfield Allotments. Council agreed to move the access gate back into the allotments about a car width, fence both sides to secure the site. This would create a space to turn a vehicle if the allotment gate was locked, meaning a car would not need to reverse down the track onto the Marlow Road. This would make it very dangerous for both the reversing vehicle and oncoming traffic on the Marlow Road.

Council noted the opposition from allotment tenants.

Council unanimously agreed to proceed with the works on safety grounds.

ii) Potential of sale of land adjoining allotments

The Parish Council has received an expression of interest in purchasing a piece of land at the end of Sandyfield Allotments.

The Parish Council received a valuation for the land, and this will be discussed in closed session.
